# Irish History # 69 - St. Patrick's Day – A Marching Tradition

Irish-Americans may be surprised to learn that the ritual of marching in a St. Patrick's Day parade was not imported from Ireland. This celebration of Irish heritage began in the United States, and it was exported to Ireland and other places. Some parades are centuries old. We will consider them, as well as what is taking place now.

For years, the NYC St. Patrick's Day parade – the granddaddy of all St. Patrick parades – was considered to be the first one. On March 15, 1762, Irish soldiers in the British army marched in lower Manhattan in honor of Ireland's patron saint. The NYC event was a display of national pride by Irishmen in America. It started a tradition on this side of the Atlantic Ocean. Thanks to committed Irish-Americans, the NYC parade has been held for 258 consecutive years. Neither economic depression, world war nor harsh weather has interrupted the annual showcase. Unfortunately, the streak will be broken this year, because the coronavirus caused the parade's cancellation.

Big city St. Patrick parades throughout the nation followed New York's - Boston, Chicago, Newark, Philadelphia, San Francisco, Savannah, Washington D.C. – as did parades in other countries. In 1824, Montreal held its first St. Patrick's Day parade. It is the oldest in Canada. The parade draws thousands of participants and a few hundred thousand spectators along Rue Ste. Catherine. While it is considered to be a spring event, it can be downright cold on parade day. When I attended, it was a brisk 15 degrees in the sun. Nevertheless, the crowd enjoyed listening to numerous pipe bands and watching the 2 1/2 hour-long march. Irish-Canadians are a hearty bunch.

It was not until 1903 that Ireland held its first St. Patrick's Day parade. That was the same year March 17th became a public holiday in Ireland. (March 17th was already a holy day.) The parade took place in Waterford. Dublin did not have its first government sponsored parade until decades later. Since then, St. Patrick's Day celebrations in Dublin have grown into a week-long event. Those celebrations were cancelled this year due to the coronavirus.

Recently, New York lost its claim to being number one. New research shows residents of St. Augustine, Florida held a procession through city streets in March 1601 to honor of St. Patrick. The parade was said to be influenced by an Irish priest in St. Augustine. Once he passed from the history books, so too did the parade. If you are looking to attend a warm-weather event, you may want to consider

the re-established St. Augustine St. Patrick's Day Parade. Despite the loss of its number one status, New York remains the oldest continuous parade.

New Jersey has more than 20 St. Patrick's Day parades. Most of them were cancelled this year. The cancellation list included the Newark St. Patrick's Day Parade, which was celebrating its 85th anniversary. Many of your fathers and grandfathers may have marched in that parade. Some participants, like the Cryan Association, marched along streets in the Vailsburg section of Newark for decades before becoming part of the Union County St. Patrick's Day Parade. This parade, which began 23 years ago, is one of the premier St. Patrick parades in the State.

For many years, the Newark parade was the largest in New Jersey. That changed when it was overtaken by the Belmar/Lake Como St. Patrick's Day Parade. Our local parade is by far the largest in the State. And it is certainly the best! Over 100 groups participate in a march that is enjoyed by more than 100,000 spectators annually. We are fortunate that the Belmar/Lake Como St. Patrick's Day Parade took place on March 1st, prior to the virus shutdown, and we should be grateful for another grand afternoon.

Since you are marching, you may not realize how impressive it is to watch hundreds of Shillelaghs wearing green jackets moving in unison down Main Street. The FSOS Belmar is by far the largest contingent of any group in the parade. That alone is visually striking. Following the best pipe band in the State – the Pipes and Drums of the Jersey Shore Shillelaghs – in the march, the FSOS is a spectacular sight. It would be even more majestic if all marchers stayed in line. The pipe band does, and seeing and hearing them along the parade route is dazzling. They make us proud to be Shillelaghs. And we should make them feel equally proud when we march. Frank Lemken does a fine job setting-up the line of march. Most keep it. But a few fail to maintain it, causing some deterioration as the march progresses. Line shifting, jumping and breaking should be eliminated. If it is, spectators will most assuredly be spellbound when the FSOS marches by.

In light of the parade cancellations, many are already thinking about how they will march next year. We should too. Stay safe and healthy. Happy Easter to you and your families. And remember the Rising!

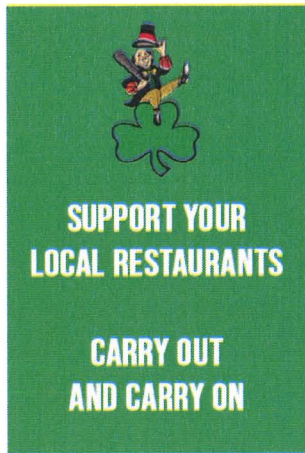

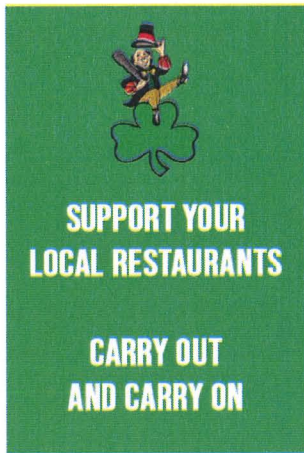

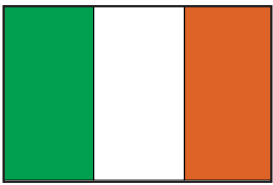
